Terraces and sediment blocks are installed on the highly erodible land that the Telkamps farm. The Telkamps have enrolled 138 acres into the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). The CREP acres will be seeded down to native grasses and be protected perpetually. Also, 21 acres of drained wetlands will be restored on the CREP acres to improve water quality and wildlife habitat.
